

# THE IRON CURTAIN™

## INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

The Iron Curtain will add to the amount of cubic ft. you can load providing you use it properly. Always strive for either a flat wall or a 2 or 3 ft wide tier at the end of your load so that you can use The Mover's Plank or logistic bars with The Iron Curtain to provide a flat straight surface for the next load. These are examples of how to use it properly.

**A.** Using Alanann, Inc.'s Movers Plank or a ladder, install the curtain into the top of the E-track of the truck with the logo facing the back of the van.

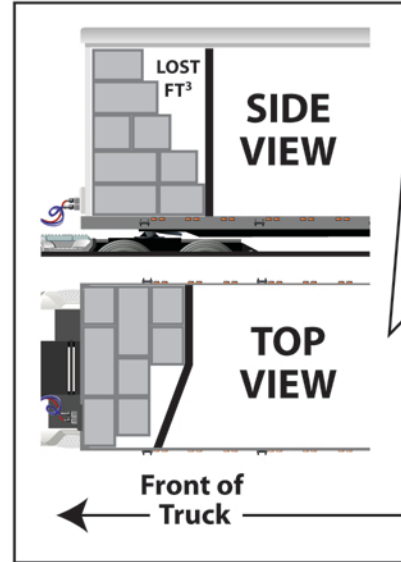
**B.** Lock E-clips into the E-track of the truck working from top to bottom.

**C.** Pull on the cam buckles to tighten.

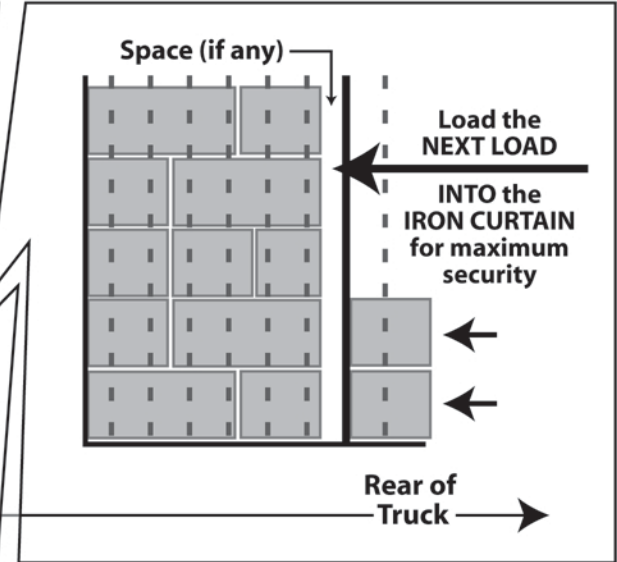
**D.** The curtain was designed as a retaining wall, to be loaded into from the rear of the truck, rather than to secure the shipment in front of it.

**The IRON CURTAIN is available in two sizes, to fit all trucks from 93 in. to 101 in. wide.**

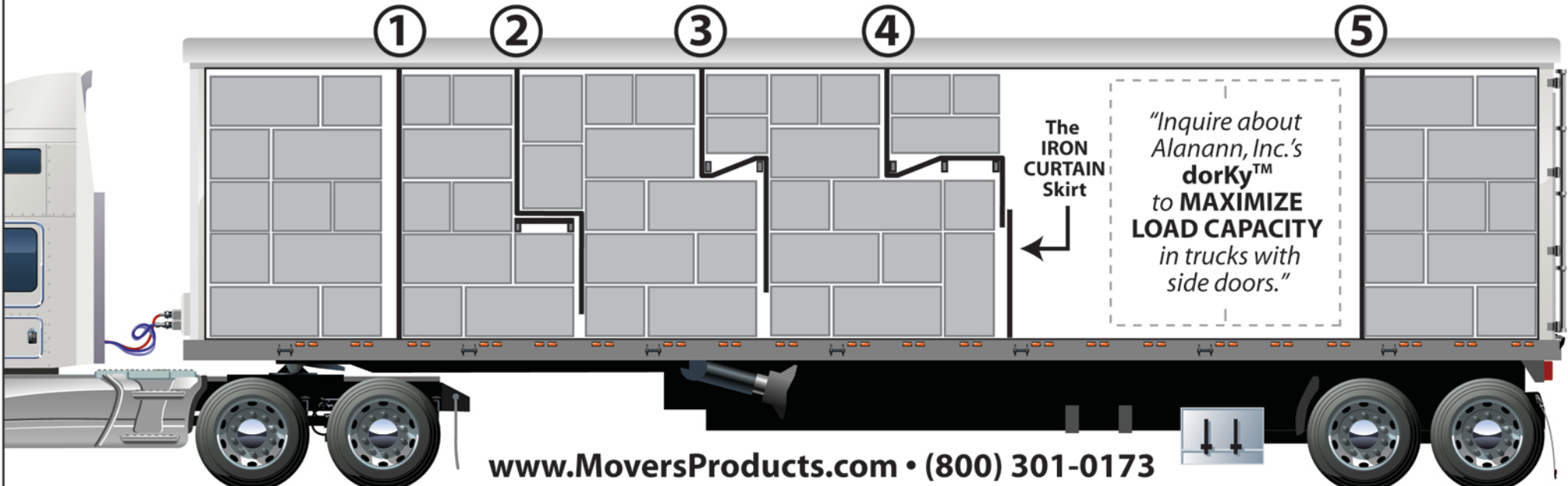
**1.** The IRON CURTAIN is used as a retaining wall, to keep separated loads from shifting forward during braking.

**2.** The IRON CURTAIN can be used in concert with Alanann's MOVER'S PLANK to create sturdy and secure tiers.

**3.** The IRON CURTAIN also works with standard movers' logistic bars to achieve similar sturdy tiering.

**4.** The IRON CURTAIN SKIRT provides additional length to the retaining wall, to safely secure the bottom of tiered loads.

**5.** The IRON CURTAIN saves you MONEY and creates GOOD WILL, by preventing damage during transport!
